ACTIVITY PACKET

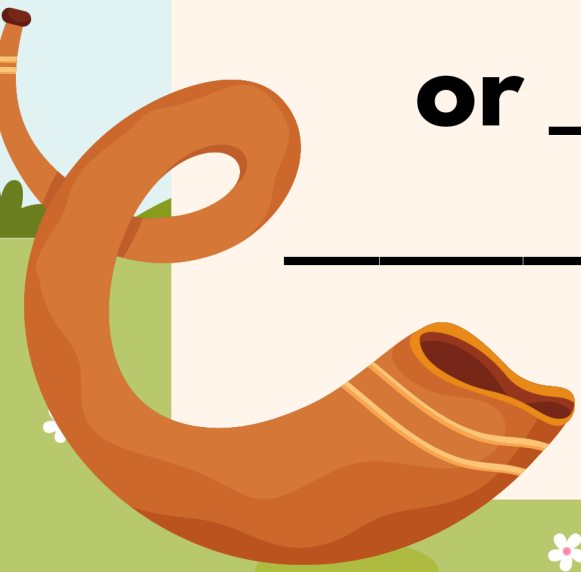
Welcome to the Feast of Trumpets (Yom Teruah) activity packet! This is a time to celebrate, blow the shofar, and remember Yahuah's special day of calling His people together. Let's have some fun learning about Yom Teruah through these activities!

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INTRODUCTION TO YOM TERUAH

Yom Teruah means 'Day of Shouting' or 'Day of Blasting.' This is the day we sound the alarm to gather people together, call them to Yahuah, and remind them of the upcoming Day of Atonement. Yom Teruah marks the beginning of the final appointed times of the year. It's a time to reflect, gather, and prepare ourselves for Yom Kippur. We blow the shofar as a signal to assemble before Yahuah and as a warning to the nations.

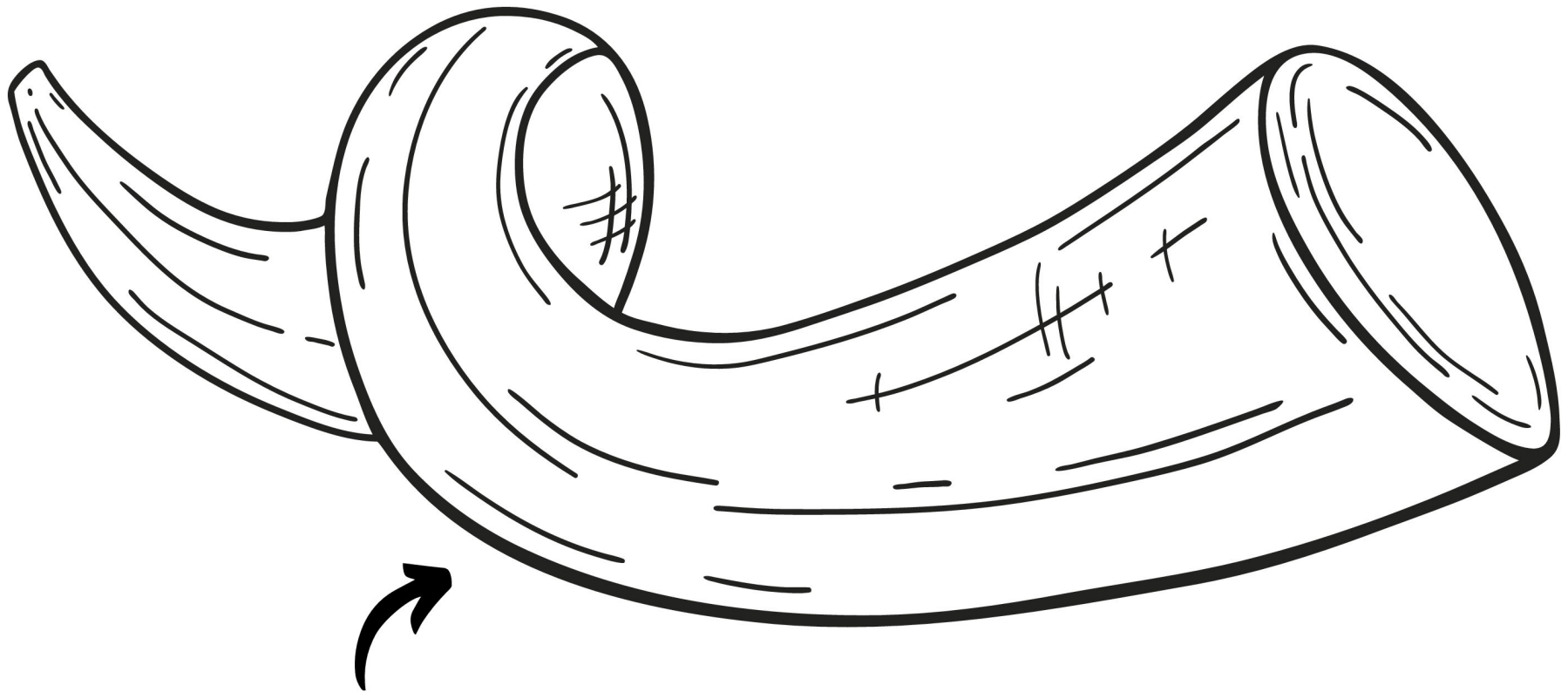

SOUND THE ALARM

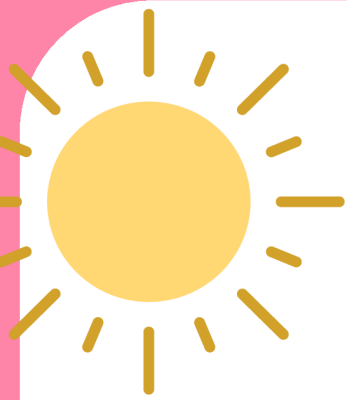
FOR YOUNGER CHILDREN

The shofar is blown on Yom Teruah to remind us to wake up, gather together, and come before Yahuah! We blow it to make a joyful noise and praise Yahuah.

WHY DO WE CELEBRATE YOM TERUAH? FOR OLDER CHILDREN



Yom Teruah is an important time to gather, reflect, and prepare our hearts for the Day of Atonement. It's a day to sound the alarm, calling Yahuah's people to come together. We blow the shofar to signal a time to reflect on our walk with Yahuah, warn the nations, and remind us to be ready for Yahushua's return!

THE STORY OF JERICH0

FOR OLDER CHILDREN

On Yom Teruah, we also remember the story of Jericho from Joshua Chapter 6. The children of Yisra'el marched around the city for seven days, and on the seventh day, they blew the shofars and shouted loudly. The walls of Jericho came crashing down, showing us the power of Yahuah's commands.

CRAFT: MAKE YOUR OWN SHOFAR FOR YOUNGER CHILDREN

Let's make our own shofars! You can use paper, markers, and some creativity to build a mini shofar that reminds you of Yom Teruah.

1

Cut the tube all the way from the bottom to the top. This will be lengthwise.

2

Wrap the tube into a thin cone shape.



- 1 cardboard tube – paper towel size
- Scissors
- Clear packing tape or masking tape
- Paint
- A paintbrush

3

Tape the bottom of the cardboard shofar.

4

Tape the top of the cone. Also add a strip of tape up the seam if needed.

5

Paint the outside of the cone.

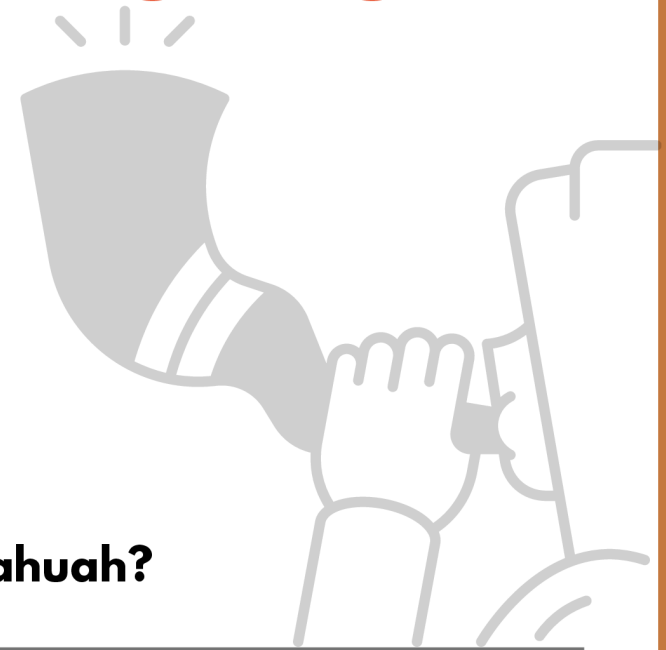

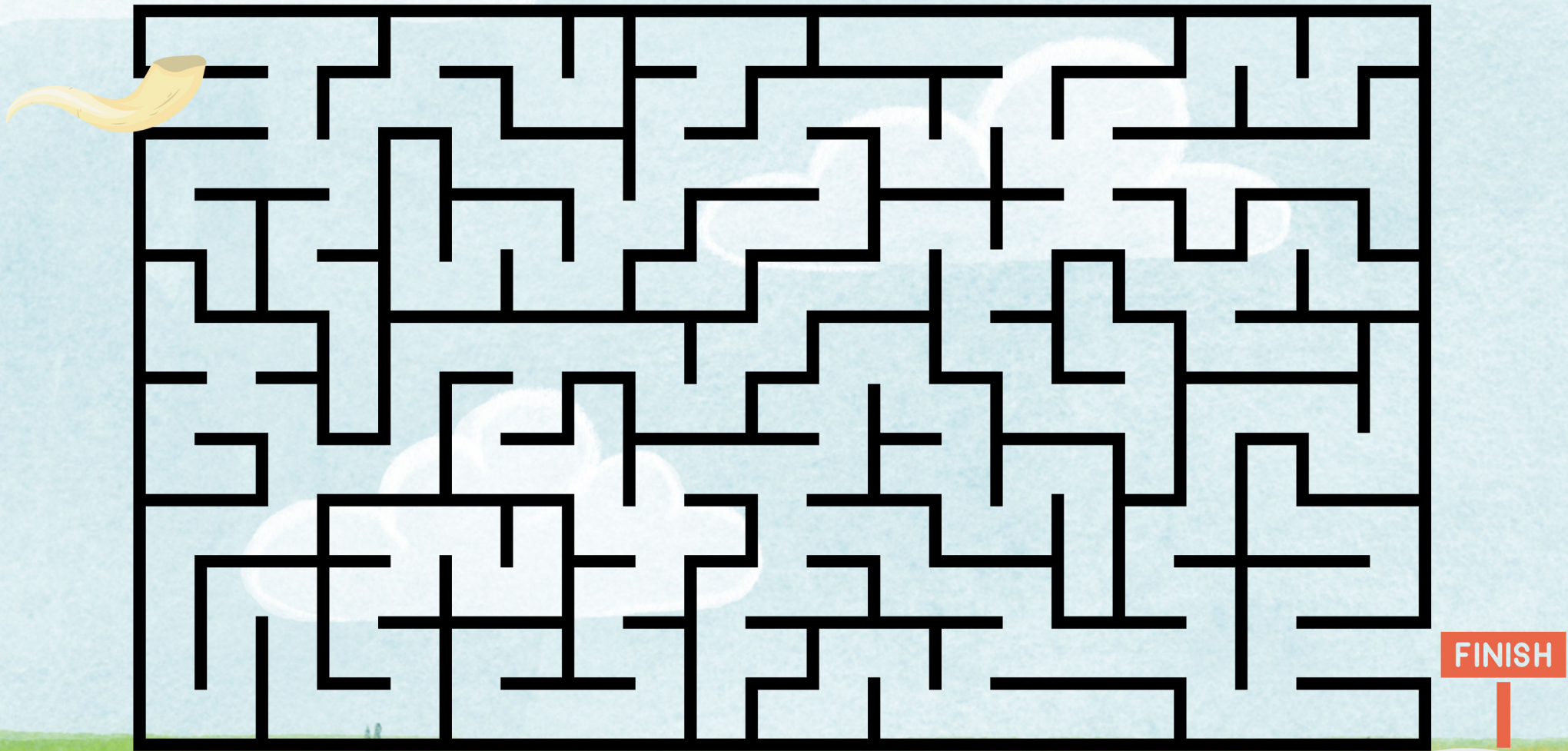
Shofars are hidden throughout this picture. Can you find them all?

The shofar needs to get to the assembly before Yom Teruah begins. Can you help it find its way?

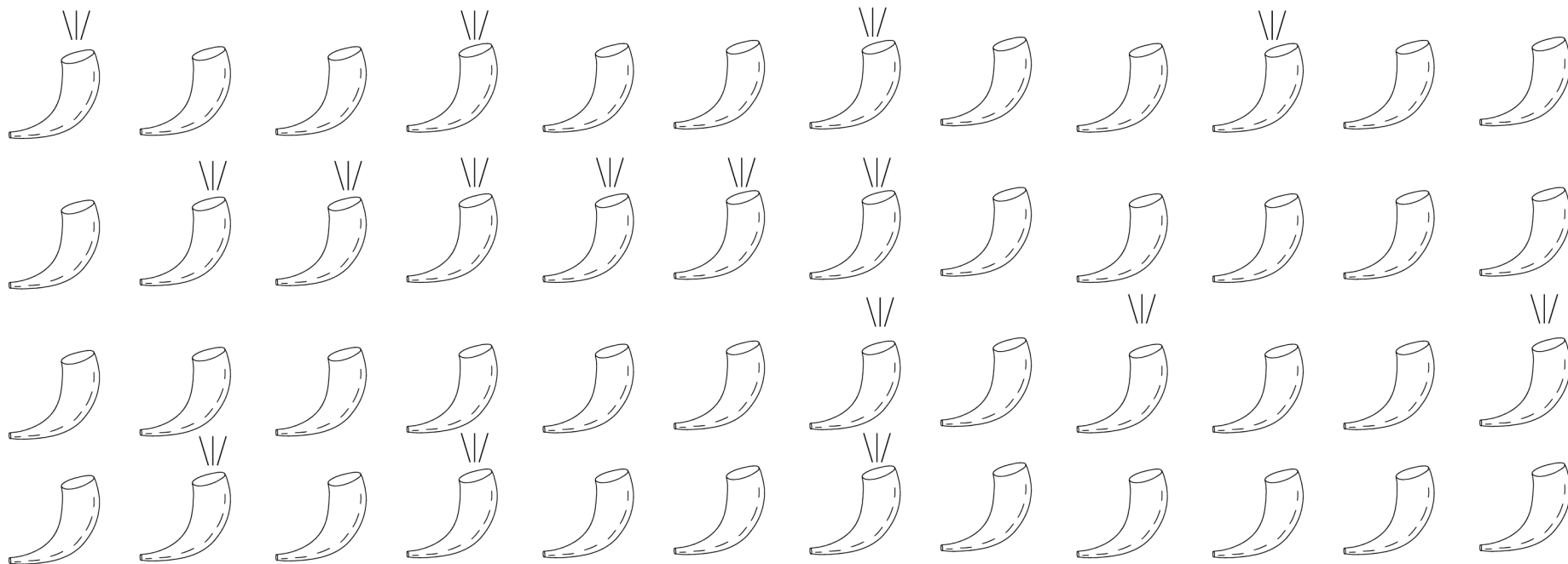


TRUMPET BLASTS PUZZLE
