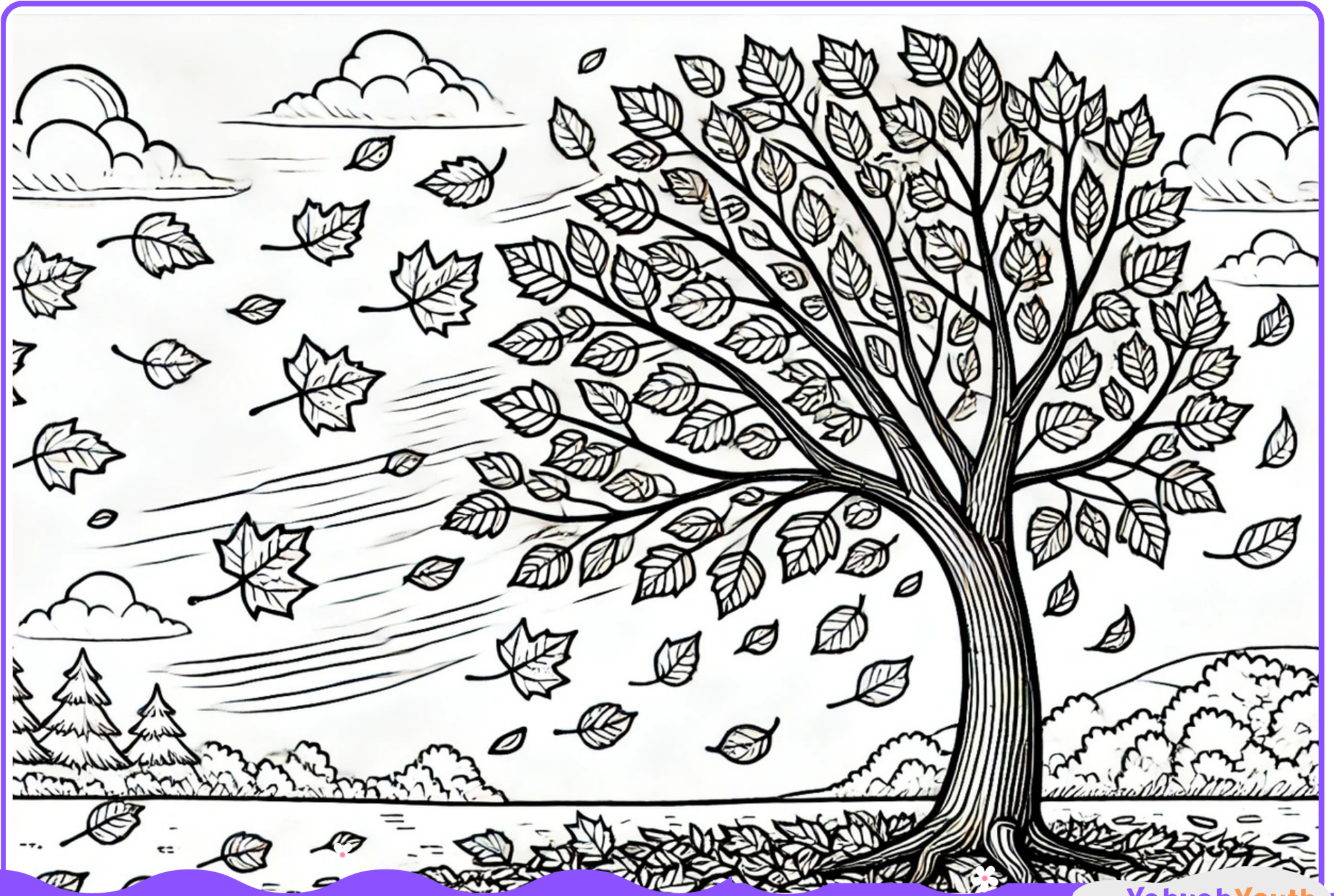

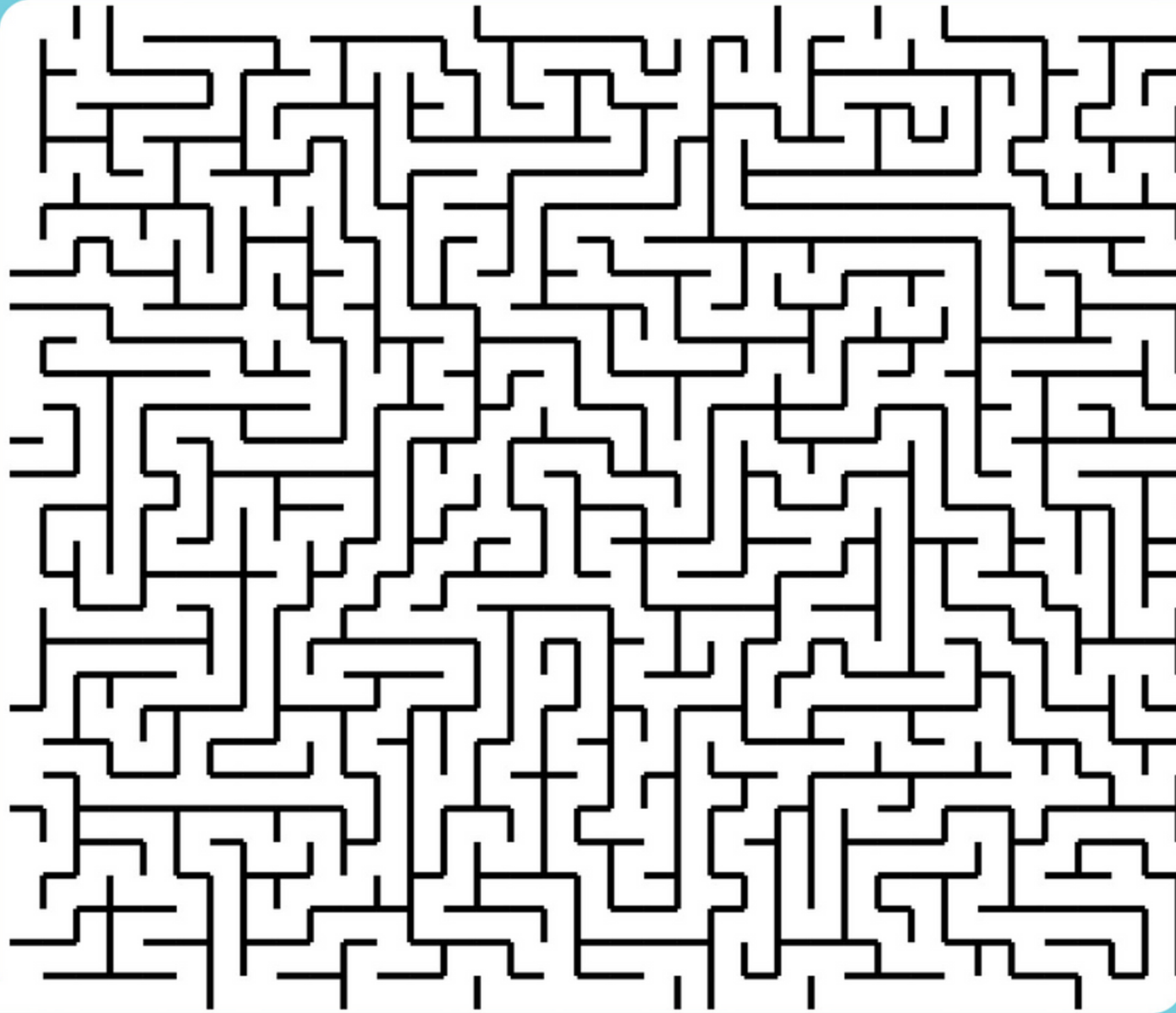

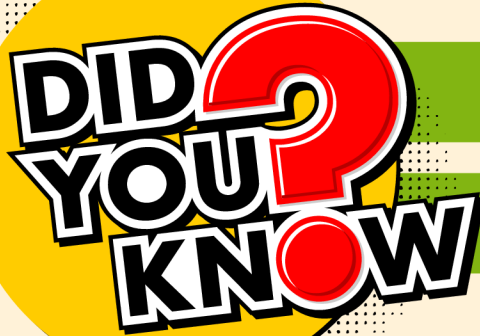


# DID YOU KNOW?

The children of Israel didn't always live in sukkahs during Sukkot. Yahuah told them to live in sukkahs to remember their time in the wilderness when He took care of them. This command started when Moses was leading them, but over time, some of the Israelites stopped living in sukkahs during Sukkot.

Later, when the Israelites came back to their land from being in Babylon, Nehemiah helped them start living in sukkahs again. They hadn't done this since the days of Joshua, and when they did, there was lots of joy and celebration!

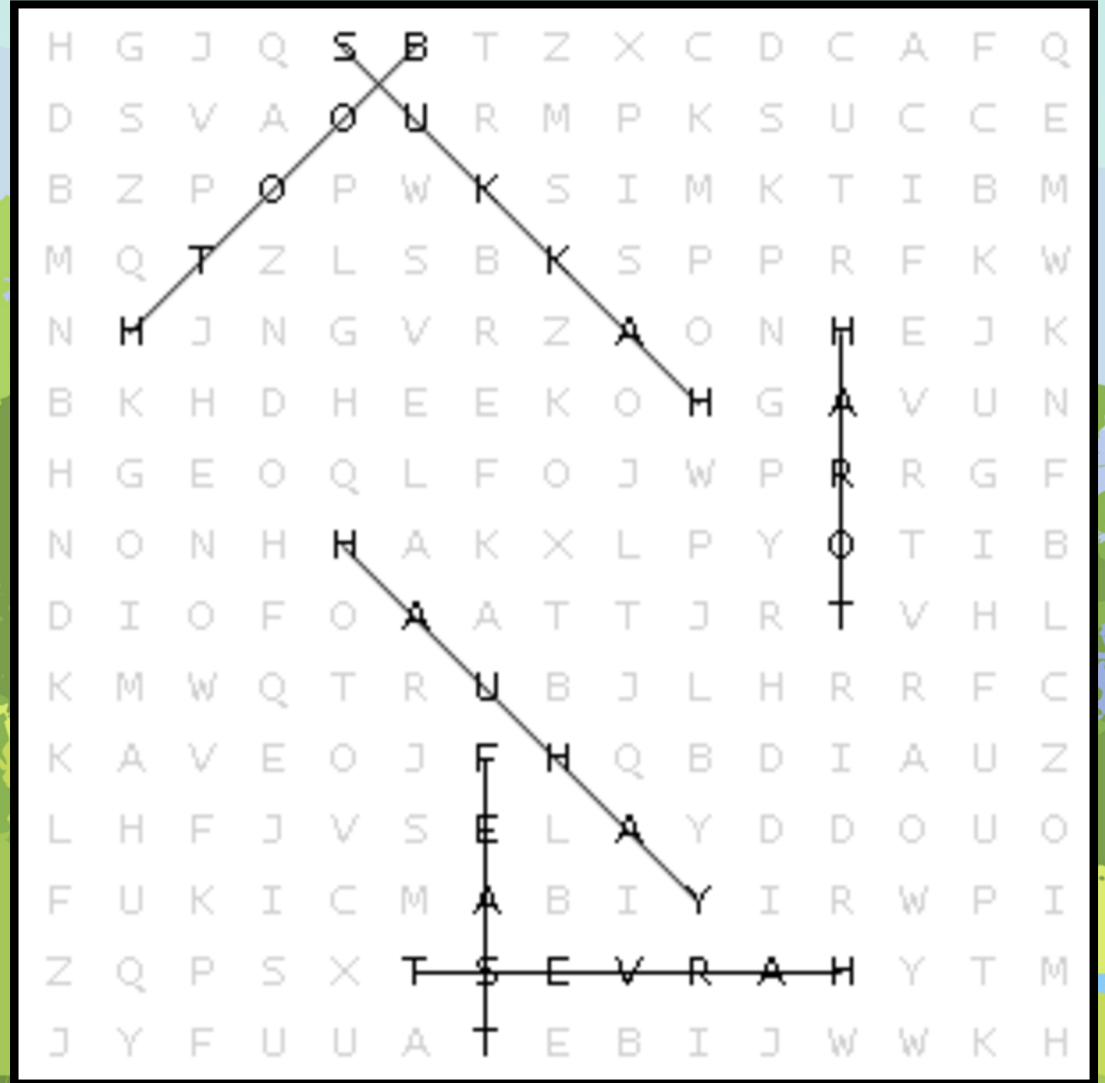
