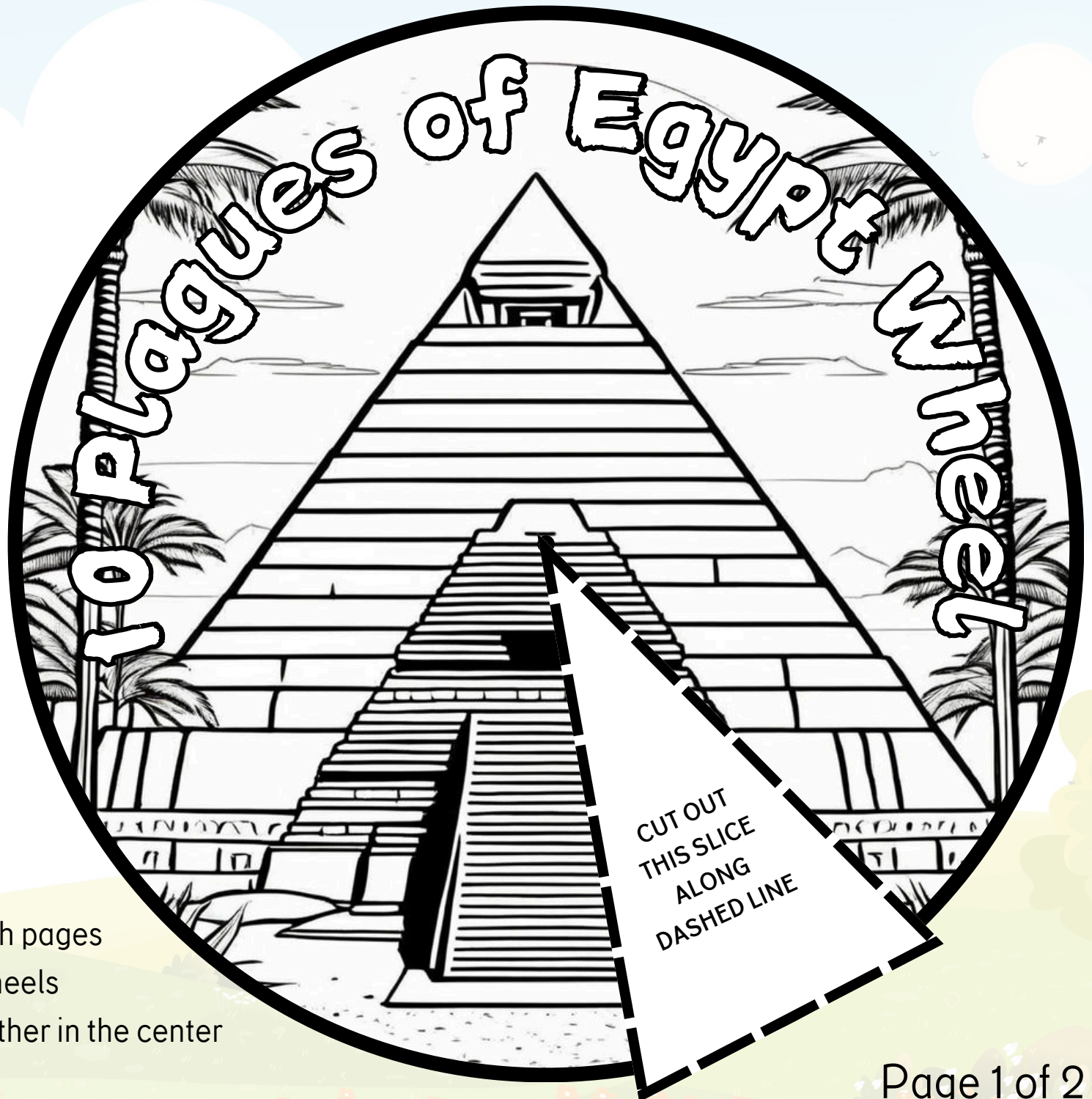
10 Plagues Of Egypt story Wheel

Instructions:

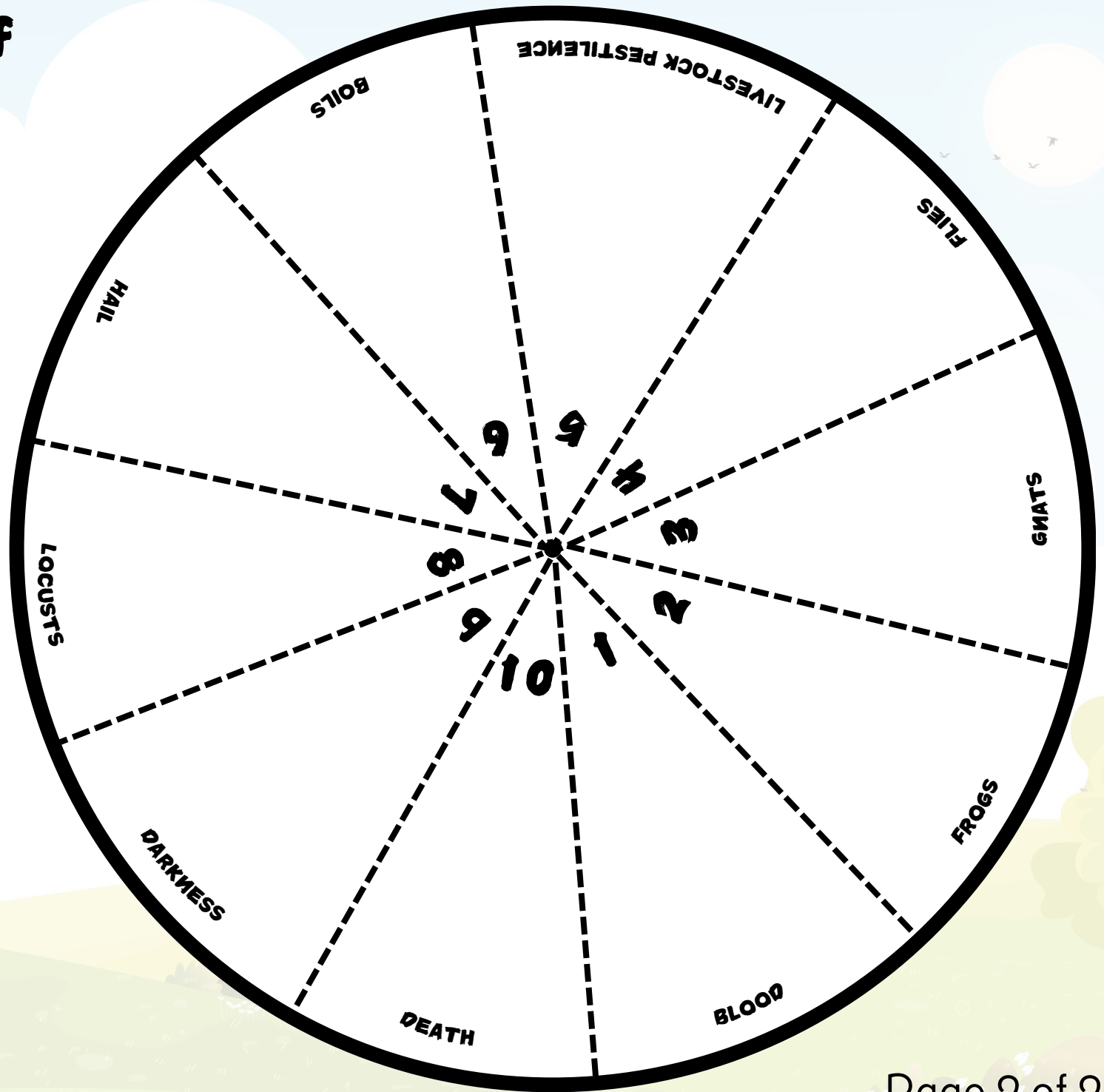
1. color the wheels on both pages

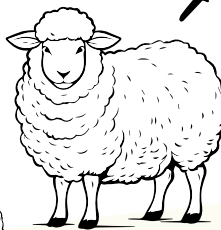
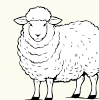
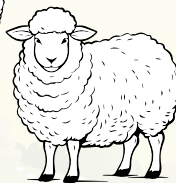
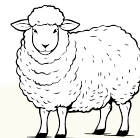
Moshe and the Burning Bush

And Elohim said to Mosheh, "I am that which I am." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Yisra'ël, 'I am has sent me to you.'"

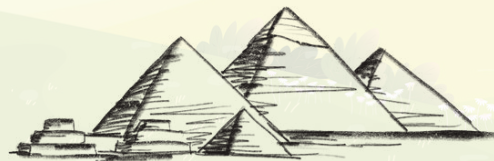


What was home?



When Moshe lived in Egypt, he and generations of Israelites from the time of Joseph, lived as the Egyptians lived and over time followed many of their customs.

The Israelites lived in Egypt, primarily in the land of Goshen. Based on archaeological and historical evidence, they likely lived in simple dwellings, possibly mud-brick houses, similar to those of the common people in ancient Egypt. They were likely small, single-story structures.

“Let the lamb be a perfect one, a year old male. Take it from the sheep or from the goats.



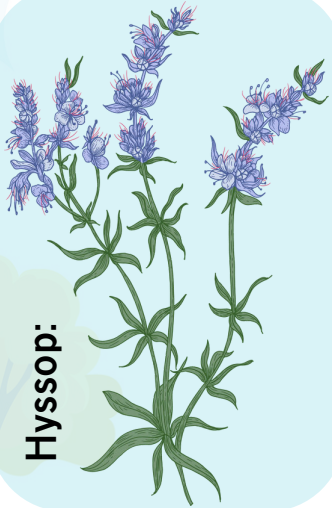

The night of the first passover, the blood of a lamb was used to cover every israelite doorpost for protection..

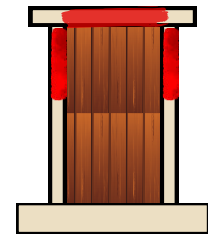


Hyssop:
