JAMES SON OF ZEBEDEE & A CLOSE FRIEND OF YAHUSHA



JAMES, ALONG WITH HIS BROTHER JOHN AND PETER, WERE CLOSE FRIENDS OF YAHUSHA MASHIACH, OUR SAVIOR. MARK 14:32-33 SAYS, 32. "THEY WENT TO THE PLACE CALLED GETHSEMANE, AND YAHUSHA SAID TO HIS DISCIPLES, 'SIT HERE WHILE I PRAY'. 33. HE TOOK PETER, JAMES AND JOHN ALONG WITH HIM ..."



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MEANING: SUPPLANTER OR ONE WHO FOLLOWS



JAMES WAS ONE OF YAHUSHA MASHIACH'S FIRST DISCIPLES, AND THE FIRST TO DIE FOR TEACHING THE GOSPEL. HE WAS ALSO A FISHERMAN AND THE BROTHER OF JOHN. MATHEW 4:21-22 SAYS, "GOING ON FROM THERE, HE (YAHUSHA) SAW TWO OTHER BROTHERS, JAMES THE SON OF ZEBEDEE, AND JOHN HIS BROTHER, IN THE BOAT WITH ZEBEDEE THEIR FATHER, MENDING THEIR NETS. HE CALLED TO THEM, AND IMMEDIATELY THEY LEFT THE BOAT AND THEIR FATHER, AND FOLLOWED HIM."
