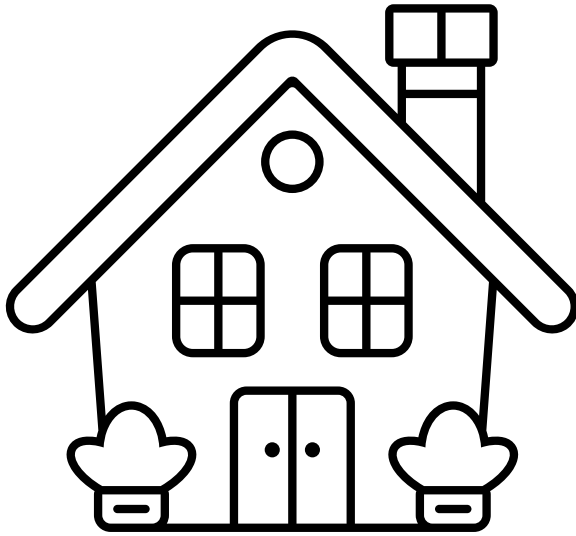

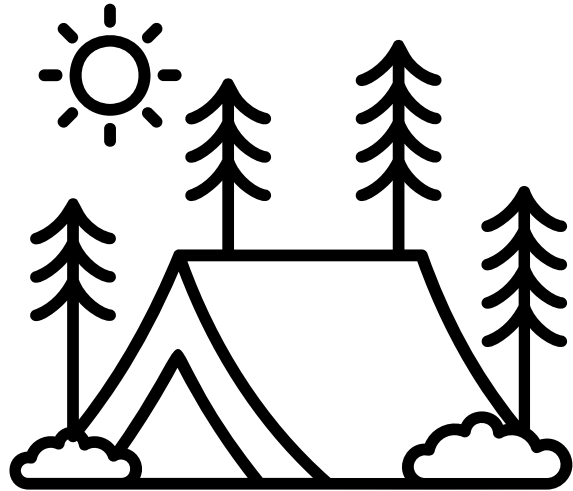


Sukkot Dwelling

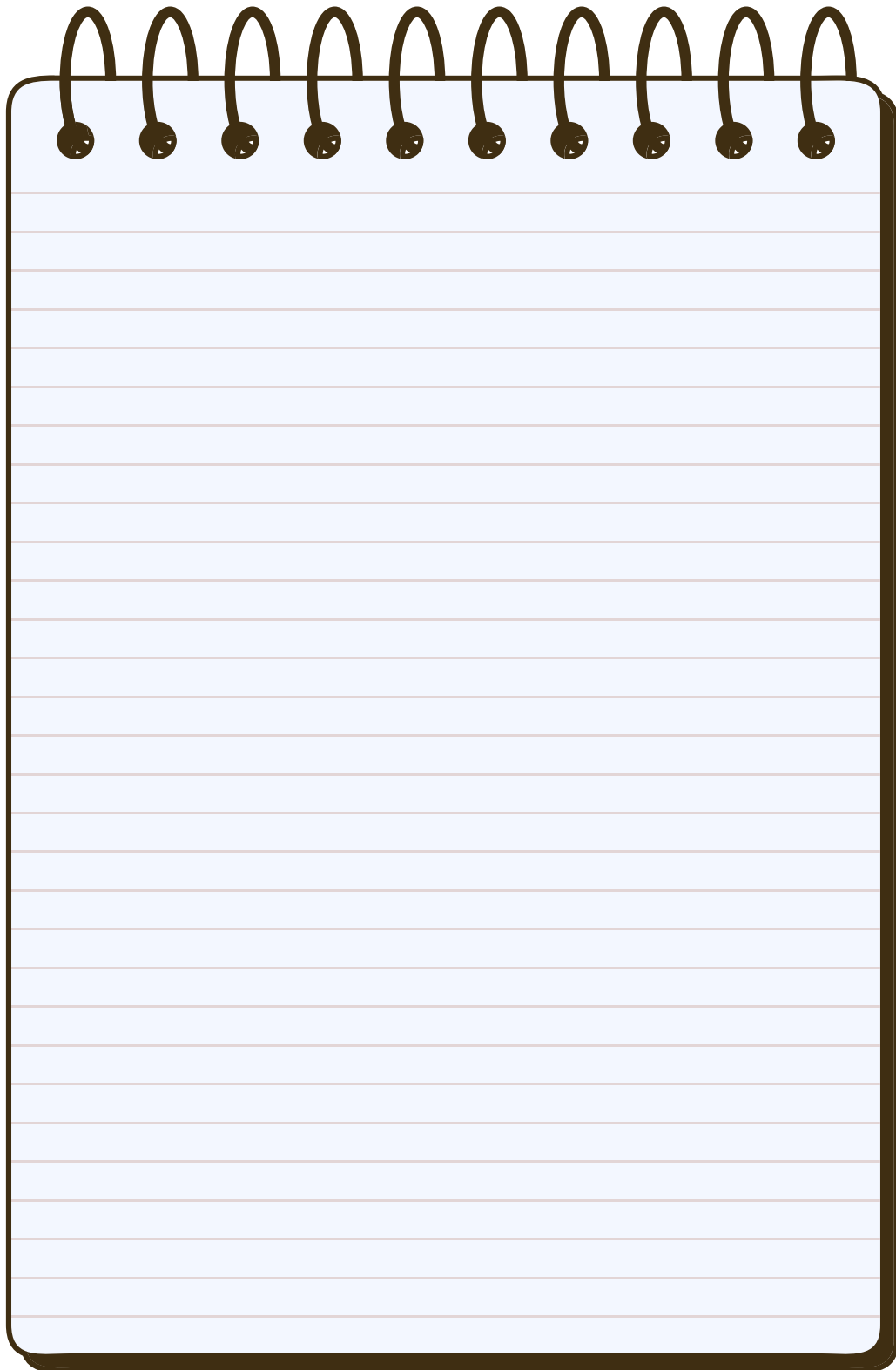
Tracing
