Simon Peter, Thomas (also known as Didymus), Nathanael (Bartholomew) from Cana in Galilee, the sons of Zebedee, and two other disciples were together" (John 21:1-2)



Bartholomew was one of Yahusha's 12 disciple's or in other words he was one of Yahusha's students. He was later promoted to an apostle. An apostle is no longer a student but a teacher of what he has learned. Bartholomew is also believed to have been known as Nathanael too, Nathanael being his given name and Bartholomew meaning son of Tolmai as his surname. John 21:2 does not mention Bartholomew, but Nathanael is listed instead.
